Outline of Activity:

Represent students and support the aims of the Students' Union by gathering feedback from students and attending meetings. Student Councillors are members of the UUSU Student Council which passes Union policies and holds the Student Executive Officers officers to account. They are elected by their peers at the beginning of Semester 1.

Learning Outcomes:

Leadership, Representation, Communication.

Anticipated Level of Commitment:

A minimum of 30 hours in the year.

This will be spent attending training sessions, UUSU meetings and also talking to students or promoting SU campaigns. Attendance at 75% of scheduled meetings is required, as well as evidence of engaging with students in between these meetings. This will be recorded and verified by UUSU staff.

A Logbook must be completed detailing your activities and reflecting on the outcomes and how they have enhanced your employability. This must be completed within the academic year which the activity was carried out and must be verified by the appropriate person and forwarded to the Students' Union.
